

# Lincoln Chess Foundation K-12 Summer Chess Camp

July 27-31, 2026

## At Boys Town National Headquarters

Join a fine cast of experienced teachers including special guest GM Viktor Matviishen USCF 2621 at this summer's chess camp on July 27<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> from 9AM-3PM daily at Boys Town National Headquarters here in Omaha at 14100 Crawford ST. This event will be open to players in K-12 of all skills and abilities and your entry will include a commemorative T-Shirt and lunches provided all five days at 11:30. Space is limited so once all slots are filled no more applicants will be accepted. No on-site/late registration.

### **Schedule:**

Sessions M-F AM from 9:00-11:30, lunch 11:30-12:30 and PM sessions from 12:30-3:00 PM. Parents should drop their children off no sooner than 8:15 daily and should pick them up no later than 3:45 PM.

Students will be grouped based on rating and estimated chess ability but the director will consider requests to be placed in a different group depending upon age and student and parent requests. Space in the advanced group will be limited to players with significant chess skills and abilities. All 4 groups will have a chance during the week to play against and interact with GM Matviishen

### **4 Groups of chess instruction being offered with recommendations based on rating:**

**Beginners**-Players should at least know how the pieces move and how to set up the board and some basic knowledge of how to play the game. Suitable for players that are unrated or rated as high as 799.

**Advanced Beginners**-Players who are rated between 800 and 1200 and have played in rated tournaments. Players in this group have a basic knowledge of checkmates and how to play the game and hope to improve their rating in the future.

**Intermediate**-Players rated from 1201-1699 and are experienced in playing in Open tournaments as well as scholastic events. Players who have only played in RBOs should consider either the advanced beginner's group or this group if they want to take the next leap forward.

**Advanced**-Players in this group must be given permission or have a rating of at least 1700. They will be working extensively with GM Matviishen throughout the week. Space in this group is limited to no more than 10.

**Fees:** \$299.00 per person if by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. \$325.00 after July 1<sup>st</sup> until all slots are filled.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Beginner**-Limited or only basic knowledge of chess. Beginners should minimally know the names of the pieces and how they move and their value in points. This group is open to unrated players with no tournament experience or to players with ratings below 800 (100-799).

\_\_\_\_\_ **Advanced Beginner**-Players in this group should have a rating of at least 800-1200 and some tournament experience. They know how to find simple checkmates and combinations.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Intermediate**-Players in this group should have ratings of at least 1000 but recommended for players rated from 1200-1600. They should have fairly extensive tournament experience. Older high school students who have lower ratings may register for this group if they feel comfortable being with older kids.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Advanced**-Players in this group must be rated above 1700 or with special permission as space is limited to no more than 10. K-12 Students with A or Expert ratings will be given first consideration.
